### 2023-2024 Academic Year

Billing information concerning Illinois State University tuition and fees for the 2023-24 academic year.

Tuition and mandatory fees have been set regardless of the mode of instruction and cover a variety of short- and long-term expenses which continue regardless of the instructional mode or access to campus facilities. The mode of instruction may be adjusted. Tuition and fees will not be refunded in the event instruction occurs remotely or the mode of instruction changes for any part of the 2023-24 academic year. Illinois State University will continue to follow published withdrawal and refund policies concerning tuition and fees.

Undergraduate tuition (in-state/out-of-state) and mandatory fees\* shall freeze based on the following tables. The duration of the initial freeze rate depends on the qualified primary major/sequence carried within the individual's catalog year as of the last day of the last undergraduate semester attended within the four continuous calendar years after being classified as first enrolled.

If during a future semester, a student becomes classified as a graduate, the prevailing graduate rates and mandatory fees shall apply. *Please note: Mandatory fees (effective Fall 2017), insurance, installment, etc., are not considered frozen fees.*

Upon the expiration of the initial and additional two-year freeze periods, the prevailing rates shall apply.

**Qualifications and rates are subject to change pending any future Board of Trustees, legislative, or University Administrative action.**

Definition of first semester enrolled—Must be an undergraduate student in a degree-seeking program, including the "General Student" classification and in attendance as of the official "10th-day census." If carrying a primary major/sequence of unclassified (065.00) when first enrolled, the tuition freeze will not apply. If carrying a primary major/sequence in the Integrated Accountancy B.S./M.P.A. program (382.00, 382.01, or 382.02) or Integrated Languages, Literatures, and Cultures B.A./M.A. program (314.00, 314.12, 314.13, or 314.15) when first enrolled, the student is considered as an undergraduate student for purposes of this definition. Classification of graduate status in a prior semester does not disqualify eligibility for tuition freeze.
